

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS AND ACCOMMODATIONS

It is the aim and practice of the Board to provide a program of training and education that meets the needs of all children in the Augusta School District to the greatest possible extent. Therefore, in addition to the basic instructional program, the Board shall offer as wide a range of special education programs as state law may require, and budgetary limits will allow.

Special programs shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the law, and with the Department of Education's regulations regarding special education.

Where appropriate, programs may be administered jointly under a cooperative agreement with other administrative units, as permitted by law.
