

SUMMER SCHOOLS

It is the practice of the Board to sponsor summer programs, within budgetary limitations.

Directors of summer programs shall be appointed by the Board upon recommendation of the superintendent. Teachers for summer sessions shall be recruited from the regular staff insofar as possible. The Board shall make appointments and set salaries for summer teaching assignments.

No students may be required to enroll in the summer program. However, students who enroll shall be required to attend regularly or shall be dropped from the summer roll. Credits received may be applied to graduation requirements with the approval of the school principal.

The director of each summer program shall submit an annual report to the Board which will include the number of students served, the courses offered and a budget summary of expenses.

All summer programs shall be subject to annual approval by the Board.
