

**CANCELLATION OF AFTER-SCHOOL STUDENT ACTIVITIES DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER**

The Board of Education stresses that student safety is paramount and that parental judgment prevails in cases of attendance at after-school activities during inclement weather.

In the event that inclement weather causes the cancellation of school, the following procedures will be followed:

- (a) If school is cancelled prior to noon at Cony High School and the middle schools and prior to 1:00 PM at the elementary schools, and the weather improves after that time, students may be requested to participate in organized after-school activities. No penalty will be assessed for student absence in the extra-curricular activity under this circumstance.

The principal will make the decision regarding holding after-school student activities on inclement weather days after consultation with the superintendent of schools. The principal will also consult the bus supervisor and other weather agencies as needed.

- (b) If school is cancelled after noon or 1:00 PM at secondary and elementary schools respectively, no after school student activities will be held.
