Leadership Education Conference (LEC)

LEC is a program attended by up to 6 high school (or 7 middle school) students who will have leadership roles in their JMG Career Association throughout this upcoming school year. The students will participate in several goal-oriented activities with their JMG Specialist during this event. Students will walk away from the event with the skills needed to become leaders in their Career Association and will develop a strong group dynamic.

The theme for this year's LEC is "Grit". Before attending LEC, we would ask that you complete the following with your students:

- Have your students create a poster (22 x 28 will be fine for this) about "What Grit Means to (Your School)'s JMG Program". There are no specific requirements with this poster, but your students will present their poster to a panel of JMG alumni during day 2 of LEC.

Upon arrival at Pine Tree Camp, Specialists will receive a registration packet that will outline the evening and following day's events. Specialists are asked to keep this packet with them at all times and be aware of the times and places for their specific events. Along with dinner, there will be a guest speaker, group discussion, and some fun initiatives during Day 1 of the event.

On Day 2 of the event, students will participate in four workshops created and facilitated by JMG Specialists, JMG Alumni, the National Guard, as well as other community volunteers. These workshops will require cooperation, flexibility, adaptability and accountability. Workshops are indoors and outdoors so please remind students about appropriate clothing and footwear for rain or shine.

This year, we will have heated cabins at Pine Tree Camp! However, we would still encourage students and Specialists to bring warm clothes for both day and night. There are no showers available, so people do not need to pack shampoo, hair dryers, etc.
