

EARLY GRADUATION

Third year students who acquire credits in all courses required by the state and the school unit which give a total accumulation of 24 units may receive their high school diplomas at the end of the third year. It is the Board's intent that early graduation requests be given careful consideration and to ensure that early graduation is in the best educational interest of the student.

The following shall be required of any student seeking early graduation:

- A. Any student requesting early graduation must do so by June 15 of his/her second year.
- B. The student must provide a strong written rationale for the request, including a detailed career and continuing education plan.
- C. The student's parent/guardians must provide a letter supporting the student's request.
- D. The student must take no fewer than six credits his/her final year at Cony High School. No more than 6 (six) credits applied toward graduation requirements can be acquired from any other source unless approved in advance by the Guidance Counselor and the High School Principal.
- E. The student must show acceptable progress and meet the minimum requirement in order to be awarded a school diploma.
