

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS
(Vocational Programs)

The Augusta Department of Public Schools shall operate a Regional Vocational Center to serve those students attending Cony High School, Gardiner Area High School, Hall-Dale High School, Winthrop High School, Maranacook Community School, and Erskine Academy.

A Vocational Advisory Committee, composed of the superintendent of the participating high schools served and one Board member elected from each school committee by its membership shall advise the Augusta Board of Education on the operation of the Center. They may develop a cooperative agreement delineating their duties and powers and a formula for sharing new program costs providing all participating units vote favorably.

As required by law, the Augusta Board of Education shall employ a director of vocational education who shall serve as the chief administrative officer of the center and its satellites and have all the authority and obligations of a secondary school principal in the school administrative unit operating the center.

Satellite Center

As authorized by law, the Augusta Board of Education may approve satellite operations at Gardiner Area High School, Hall-Dale High School, Winthrop High School, Maranacook Community School and a Wood Harvesting program at the Maranacook Community School.
