

RELATIONS WITH HEALTH AUTHORITIES

The Augusta Department of Public Schools shall cooperate with the City Health Department in all matters pertaining to the safety and healthy development of the children in the schools.

Health services, such as immunization clinics, screening procedures, and dental services, will be authorized by the superintendent and scheduled as needed.

Information regarding such services may be distributed, and accommodations may be provided as necessary; however, the Board shall not be responsible for fluoride treatments administered through the schools..

The school department shall also cooperate fully with the City Health Department in developing procedures for the control of communicable disease. All such procedures shall conform to the laws of the state and to the regulations of the State Department of Health.
