

SUPERINTENDENT'S CONSULTING ACTIVITIES

The superintendent shall devote his/her time, attention, and energy to the direction and supervision of the school system, and shall not, during the term of his/her employment, be engaged in any other business. By prior agreement with the board, however, the superintendent may undertake, for remuneration, consultative work, speaking engagements, lecturing, or other professional duties and obligations.
