

**BOARD REVIEW OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
(And Approval of Issuance)**

The board reserves the right to review administrative rules at its discretion, but it shall revise or veto such rules only when, in the board's judgment, they are inconsistent with policies adopted by the board.

Administrative rules need not be reviewed by the board in advance of issuance, except as required by state law or in cases when strong community attitudes, or possible student or staff reaction, make it necessary or advisable for the regulation to have board's advance approval.

Before issuance, regulations shall be properly titled and coded as appropriate to subject and in conformance with the codification system selected by the board.
