

## TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

The assistant superintendent for curriculum and instruction shall serve as acting superintendent in the absence of the superintendent of school.

The board may authorize the assistant superintendent to act as an agent, in the absence of the superintendent, in making applications, filing claims, and accepting funds from the federal government under National Public Law 874, Title I, II, III, IV, and V, and regular orders and bills with the City of Augusta. Such authorization shall be renewed annually and is continuous until revoked.
