MLTI iBook Sign Out Policy

The Augusta School Department's School Board is providing Apple iBooks as an instructional tool for students in the school department. This equipment is intended for the use of students in the educational process. The State of Maine retains ownership of these iBooks, while Augusta students and parents/guardians are responsible for their care and serviceability. Students will be able to take iBooks home after the following occurs:

- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must attend an orientation meeting with the student.
- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must take financial responsibility for the iBook, by purchasing off-site insurance, as provided through the Augusta School Department, before iBooks will be allowed off school property.
