

**Elementary Summer Camp Positions:**

July 6- Aug 5, 2021

Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday

8AM-12:00PM @ Cony

The camp will provide both online and in-person instruction.

Our students are in need of extra support to continue their learning beyond the school year so please consider being involved in our summer camp! We're hoping to make this a fun and engaging time for all involved. The summer camp will be 5 weeks starting July 6 to August 5; 3 days/week-Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 8-12:00. Planning time is also built into the schedule. Below is descriptions of positions available. **If you are interested in any of these positions, or have further questions, please email Theresa Violette and Katherine (Katy) Grondin by May 1.** Thank you for your consideration.

**Program Coordinator** oversees the program; coordinates parent letters, enrollment information, schedules, data and attendance, ordering, mailings, and parent information/engagement activities. He/she problem solves issues/concerns when they arise. (1 position)  
(Hours: 92)

**Teachers** will plan instruction that meets student's needs and provide ongoing support to students and families. They will help coordinate ongoing activities that engage students to be creative and problem solve, as it relates to building literacy, math and science skills. Oversee educational technicians who work in their classrooms. (10 positions)  
(Hours: 84)

**Ed Techs** will provide supplemental instruction, in coordination with teachers, to meet student needs in reading, writing and math. (10 Positions)  
(Hours: 66)

**Nurse** will provide medical care to any student or staff member requiring assistance. He/she will deal with Covid related issues, and oversee CDC protocols in consultation with the program coordinator..(1 position)  
(Hours: 60)

**Part time Librarian** will organize the collection of elementary books in the Cony Library. She will host classrooms of children weekly in the library and read aloud favorite books. (1 position)  
(Hours: 44)

**Social Worker or Guidance Counselor** will provide social emotional support and instruction for students. Meet with students individually and in groups to meet student's needs. (2 positions)  
(Hours: 66 hours and potentially more as ongoing connections are needed to meet family needs)
