

SUPERVISION OF PROFESSIONAL STAFF

Central office administrators and supervisors, principals, and assistant principals, shall be committed to the task of supervision to the end that instructional staff members may develop their teaching abilities to the optimum degree.

The purposes of supervision shall be to help the teacher analyze and improve teaching, to provide teachers with ready support and help on teaching programs, and to assure that sufficient help has been provided in overcoming any teaching programs in advance of official evaluations.

Principals shall be charged with the direct supervision of the teachers in their building, and shall provide assistance and educational leadership to their staff.

Professional ethics shall be followed by all administrators and supervisors, as it pertains to the supervision of teachers, observations in classrooms, and the filing of supervisory reports.
