

Quarter 4 Credit/Course Recovery Plan from COVID-19 for 2020-21

Cony Middle and High School

Middle School (7th and 8th Graders)

7th (Class of 2026-current 6th graders) and 8th graders (Class of 2025-current 7th graders)

- 2020-21 Courses will be scheduled as usual
- Departments will prioritize 6th and 7th grade power standards and weave Quarter 4 power standards from 2020 into 7th and 8th grade year-long classes in math, science, social studies, and English
- Quarter 4 grades will not be entered or calculated; students will have three quarters of grades for 2019-2020 with Quarter 3 as pass/fail
- Unified Arts missed in 7th grade will not be recovered for 8th graders

9th Graders

Class of 2024-current 8th graders

- 2020-2021 Courses will be scheduled as usual
- Departments will prioritize 8th grade power standards for critical understanding and weave into freshmen classes in math, science, social studies, and English
- Students will be assigned to graded courses for the first 4 weeks to review critical 8th grade concepts
- For students enrolled in World Languages in the 2nd semester as 8th graders, Quarter 4 World Language will need to be completed before enrolling in the 2nd year of the language. Logistics are being worked out.
- Quarter 4 grades (from 8th grade) will not be entered or calculated; students will have three quarters of grades for 2019-2020 with Quarter 3 as pass/fail

10th Graders, 11th Graders and 12th Graders

For Class of 2021 (current Juniors), Class of 2022 (current Sophomores), Class of 2023 (current Freshmen)

- Students will begin the 2020-21 school year with the 2020 Quarter 4 courses for four weeks
- Departments will prioritize power standards to teach new concepts from Quarter 4
- Once the 2020 Quarter 4 is completed, Cony High School students will move to 2021 Quarters 1, 2, 3, 4 (each quarter will be approximately 8 weeks instead of 9 weeks)
- 2020 Quarter 3 grades will be Pass/Fail
- 2020 Quarter 4 grades will be numerical
- There will be no final exams for 2020 2nd Semester courses or quarter classes
- 2019-2020 Year-long classes (Band, Chorus, AP classes) will have a numerical grade average from 2019-2020 Quarters 1, 2, and 4
- For 2019-20 2nd semester classes (Quarter 3 and Quarter 4), students will be issued a Quarter 4 numerical grade that will count toward the entire 2nd semester grade (Quarter 3 Pass/Fail will not be included)
