Dear Staff, Students, and Families,

This letter is to inform you that we have received information concerning two individuals at Gilbert Elementary School who have been identified as positive for COVID-19. The cases are not related, and the individuals are in isolation. The individuals did not show symptoms prior to testing positive. There are no close contacts at school that we need to notify because the individuals were already in quarantine due to a positive exposure outside of school. These cases are not related to any previous positive cases. We continue to follow CDC and Department of Education guidelines in response to an identified positive case.

We appreciate families and staff notifying us if a student or staff member and/or another family member is testing for COVID, sharing the results of the testing and whether a student or staff member is experiencing symptoms. Please continue to stay at home as directed by health protocols and the CDC. We need to continue to work together to minimize the spread of the virus.
